Please read it carefully and if necessary forward it to the responsible persons and/or the event service respectively.


In case that you cannot fulfill these requirements we kindly ask you to contact us via email or telephone.

1. STAGEPLAN:



Stage:

- Stage size at least 6 m x 4 m x 0.5 m
- Drumriser at least 2 m x 4 x
- The stage has to be easily accessible, stable, clean, weatherproof in all parts, grounded and statically safe
- There must be a suspension device to put up a banner/backdrop.

POWER OUTLET:

Schuko (230 V AC/16A) – distribution see stage plan!

Hall technique (FOH):

- A sound-engineer that is familiar with the location's PA system must be present during the whole show.
- The PA must be appropriate for the location, must be functioning and may under no circumstances be undersized!



Analogous consoles 24/8: preferably midas, soundcraft or similar Digital pults: Yamaha LS9, M7CL, DigiCo SD9 or similar.

For analogous pults please note the point "siderack"!

Miking - see schedule. Boom Microphone Stands and Microphone Stands - see schedule.

Siderack:

2x 31-band EQ for front 1x 31-band EQ for wedge (for digital pults on-board-effects and EQ, otherwise Yamaha, Klark, BSS or similar) 5x gate for drums (for digital pults on-board or DBX or similar) 3x compressor 3x FX (SPX, Lexicon)

MONITORING:

At least 4 ways with 32 band Eqs respectively.

6x identical 15/2" monitors – Setup according to stage plan
In case of separate monitor place there are the same
requirements + an additional qualified (motivated) monitor technician.

Light engineering:

- Back: 4x 6er Bar Par 64
- Front: 2x 6er Bar Par 64, 2x Fresnel lense
- · Dimmer, lighting mixer
- Qualified (motivated) light technician

3. CATERING RIDER:

Food / Beverages:

- sufficient amount of sandwiches + fruits
- sufficient amount of tea, coffee, milk, sugar
- sufficient amount of still water + at least 6 big bottles for the stage
- sufficient amount of different softdrinks (coke, sprite, juice etc.)
- 1 crate of beer
- a warm meal for 7 persons (no fastfood!) or alternatively 10 Euro per Person, payable in cash directly after the soundcheck.

4. MISCELLANEOUS:

Backstage:

- The band is provided an appropriate backstage-room from beginning to the end of the event. The room must be separated from the audience hall.
- · Access to washing and toilet area must be guaranteed.

Required helpers:

- 2 sober and strong helpers for unloading the equipment at arrival of the band
- 2 sober and strong helpers for loading the equipment at the end of the show
- Furthermore we need 6 big towels for the stage.
- In case that the backline cannot be setup on the stage immediately we need a lockable, dry and clean room near the stage for our equipment

5. MERCHANDISE:

- For our merchandise stand we need a sufficiently highlighted place of approximately 3x2 meters and a possibility to hang up shirts behind the stand.
- For the merchandise stand we need tables IN FRONT OF the stand as well as BEHIND the stand
