Hospitality Rider

Security Requirements

Contractor agrees to provide at no cost and free to use to Artist: Adequate security at all times from get-in to departure to ensure the safety of the artist, crew, instruments, equipment, vehicles, personal property.

Dressing Room

The contractor agrees to provide at no cost and free to use to artist: A dry and clean dressing room. The dressing room will be available from arrival until departure. The dressing room must be heated and fitted with a fridge, Wi-Fi, mirrors, towels and running water.

Please write down the Wi-Fi password if it is secured.

Catering

Contractor agrees to provide at no cost and free to use to Artist:

At arrival:

Available in dressing room;

- 24 bottles or cans of local beer
 - 6 bottles or cans of alcohol free beer
 - 1 bottle of Jägermeister or 1 bottle of Whiskey
 - 12 bottles or cans of soda (cola, sprite, fanta)
 - 6 cans of Red Bull
 - 12 bottles of still water
 - Fresh coffee and tea on arrival
 - Some fresh sandwiches upon arrival
 - Fruit
 - Snacks

Diner

Contractor agrees to provide at no cost and free to use to Artist: A warm nutritious meal for at least 6 (7) persons. Dinner should be available 2 hours prior to show. If the venue cannot serve dinner, a buyout of €15 per person will be paid to the band.

Hotels:

When a hotel is provided, we need 3 (4) double rooms + breakfast within 10 km's from the venue/festival site

No sleep-in etc. !!

Crew Requirements

Contractor agrees to provide at no cost and free to use to Artist: 3 (three) technicians (2x sound, 1 x lights) well acquainted with the equipment in the venue and at assistance of the Grindpad crew. These technicians should be standby during the show. Drum tech required during change-over, 2 (two) sober stagehands to unload equipment and set up plus breakdown and loading truck at the end of the show.

Merchant requirements

Contractor agrees to provide at no cost and free to use to Artist:

The venue will allow sales of our own merchandise before, during and after the show by representatives of the band. The merchandise should be near the performance area. The venue makes sure that there are tables and lights where we can put up our merchandise. We prefer a space of 1x2 meter.

Parking Requirements

Contractor agrees to provide at no cost and free to use to Artist: Parking space for 3 cars.

Guest list

We will have a minimum of 5 guest list spots.

Use of our Logo

The venue and promotor are allowed to use our logo on posters, flyers and t-shirts. When our logo is on t-shirts, the venue gives us 5 shirts (1x Medium, 2x Large, 2x Extra Large). Also, we would like to have a flyer and poster for ourselves.

Technical Rider

PA

The venue will provide a sufficient full range PA system with a minimum of 100 dBA undistorted at FOH. The venue will provide a mixing desk with at least sixteen (16) inputs. The venue will provide a capable sound engineer with knowledge of the gear who will operate the desk at FOH.

Monitors

The venue will provide a monitor system with a minimum of 100 dBA undistorted. We will need four (4) wedges up front and one (1) drum fill (sub & top). (See stage plot). The venue will provide a mixing desk with at least sixteen (16) inputs and four (4) outputs. The venue will provide a capable sound engineer with knowledge of the gear who will operate the desk at Monitor world.

Lights

The venue will provide a cable light tech with knowledge of the lights and lighting console at the venue. We play aggressive thrash metal and the light should fit that style. Smoke and stroboscopes are allowed.

Backdrop and Side banners

We use a 6x4m, 4x2m or 1x2m backdrop. This depends on the venue, please let us know which one we can put up. We would like to have some assistance with hanging it during a change-over. We bring our own hooks and tie wraps. If the venue doesn't have a proper place to hang our backdrop, please inform us at least 1 week before the show. We also have 2 side banners (2x1m) that we will place on both sides of the stages if there is enough room.

Intro

We use a intro for our show. The intro will be given to the sound engineer on a USB before the show starts.


